Bowler Expectations as we begin the Season – Phase 1

Welcome back to another season! A huge thank you to all those that were able to participate last year and helped keep each other safe as we enjoyed a strangely different season. Thankfully, there were some things about the year that were great, and some special memories were still made. As you begin this new season, please comply with the following bowler expectations.

At all times, the guidelines and legislations of Provincial and Local Health Authorities must be respected and will take precedence over these recommendations and the protocols of your club.

- If you are feeling unwell, regardless of the symptoms, stay home.
- If you have been in contact with someone that has Covid-19 or is being tested for Covid-19 (which includes yourself) you must stay home.
- Regardless of vaccination status, you must adhere to club protocols.
- Pre-register for when you would like to play; do not just show up and expect to play.
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes before your scheduled time and at all times maintain the two-meter physical distancing requirement as you arrive, on the greens, and as you leave.
- Sanitize your hands upon arrival at the club and upon leaving the club.
- Use your own bowls. If you do not own your own bowls, make sure you follow the posted safety protocols for using club bowls.
- Before you begin practice/play discuss how you will work together to avoid touching the same equipment. Two jacks and two mats are allowable for each rink. **(This applies to Single that lives alone and their 2 close contacts; all other rinks are singles or households.)**
- Do not shake hands or high five.
- Do not visit with other people on the greens but stick to your assigned rink and maintain physical distancing.
- Maintain your club's protocols for use of the washrooms.
- Bring your own water / refreshments but also take home your own waste material.
- Offer to help out at the club in whatever way you can!
- Do your part to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable time bowling!
